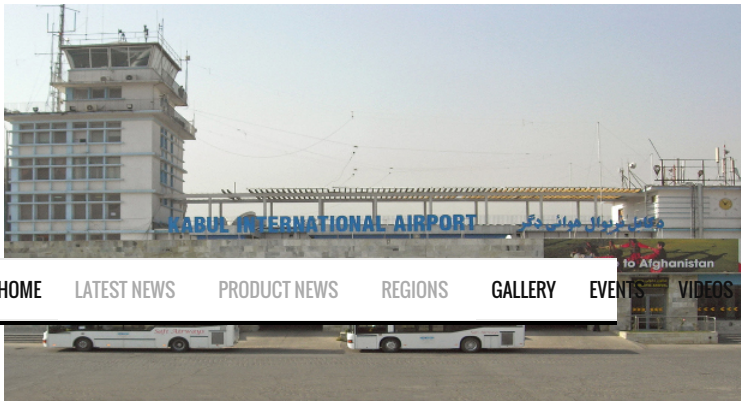




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Kam Air's new concessionaire eyes Afghan airport duty-free

HB Perfumes & Cosmetics, a distributor of branded fragrances and cosmetics in Afghanistan, has secured the inflight concession on board national carrier Kam Air and is set to grow its travel-retail business with airport, border and diplomatic duty-free shops in the country.

The company is currently in talks to open perfumes and cosmetics duty-free stores in five international airports in Afghanistan: Kabul, Mazar, Herat, Kandahar and Jalalabad International airports, Ravina Dost, assistant to managing director Amid Hafizi, said in an interview for DFNI's July 2015 issue.

The inflight concession with Kam Air commenced on June 1. The airline operates 13 daily international flights to destinations such as Russia, UAE, India and Tajikistan and is expected to expand to China in the near future.

Dost said: "The inflight concession has already started and now we are planning the construction of airport and diplomatic shops over the next two years. We plan to open one shop in each airport in the five main cities in Afghanistan, and if it goes well we will open more."
